

Growth Rings

A collaborative art project for Squamish Savings, *Growth Rings* will transform old climbing rope into a braided sculptural work with the help of the community.

Participate in this community-wide project by attending a free hour long workshop where you'll learn to weave multi-strand braids as contribution to this permanent artwork.

While the braids created will stay with the project to become part of the work, you will come away with a new skill, be part of community-building conversation around the history and current identity of Squamish, and contribute to a permanent local artwork

Please note: with the exception of invited guest speakers, the participants involved in this project will not receive any compensation for their contributions. Sincere efforts will be taken to acknowledge in the narrative, all groups who contribute to the artwork.

In addition to this independent workshop, public braiding events featuring local historian and Indigenous guests will take place throughout January and February.
